### Nighttime Parking Restriction on Empire Avenue in Burbank, Nov. 25-26

Empire Avenue will be re-striped on Tuesday night, November 25, 2014. **Parking will be restricted for seven hours on Empire Avenue while the striping operation is underway.** This work is part of the I-5 Empire Project in Burbank, a series of freeway improvements between Magnolia Boulevard and Buena Vista Street. *Construction activities and closures are subject to change.*

Four parking stalls will be restored to the north side of Empire Avenue near Liberman Broadcasting as a result of the restriping.

- **Date of Restriction:** Tuesday night, Nov. 25, to early Wednesday morning, Nov. 26.
- **Hours of Restriction:** 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- **Location:** Parking will be restricted on both sides of Empire Avenue between Victory Place and Maria Street.
- **Motorist Access:** Empire Avenue will NOT be closed during the operation. Flaggers and a designated field engineer will maintain traffic flow in both directions and ensure that all businesses on Empire Avenue remain accessible.
