CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

I-5 Empire Project LELAND WAY CHANNEL CAP UPDATE

As part of the I-5 Empire Project, Caltrans will cap the Burbank Western Channel adjacent to Leland Way to allow I-5 to be widened for new carpool lanes. This will involve using a large crane to place concrete panels over the channel. Details below.

- ▶ **When will the channel be capped?** The contractor expects to cap the channel in, tentatively, mid-2016. We will notify you when the schedule is confirmed.
- ▶ **How long will it take?** About three months.
- ▶ **Will the capping operation affect traffic on Leland Way?** The contractor will make every effort to place the panels from the freeway side of the channel. If it becomes necessary to place some of the panels from the Leland Way side, closures will be implemented to protect motorists and workers. Access to homes and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- ▶ **How will you notify us when the channel cap operation is set to begin?** Information will be available on My5LA.com, in our weekly advisory, in flyers delivered to your doorstep, and by email. To be added to the Leland Way email list, contact Kelly Markham at kelly.markham@dot.ca.gov.
- ▶ **Will any Caltrans work be done on Leland Way between now and 2016?** Yes. Crews will be doing finishing work on barriers and constructing footings for sign structures. These operations may require minor closures of limited duration.
- ▶ **What's happening with street parking?** On Sept. 30, 2015, street parking on the residence side of Leland Way was restored. It may be necessary to restrict parking during panel placement in 2016, but we do not anticipate any long-term parking restrictions on the residence side of the street between now and then.
